# Note names

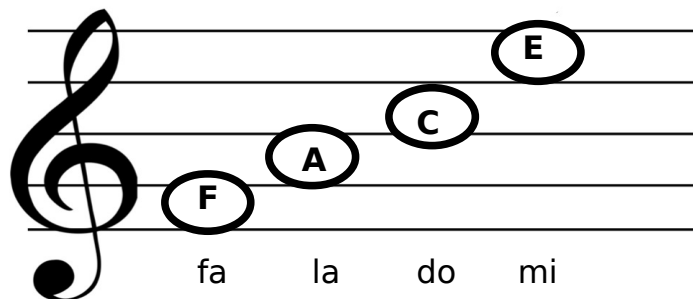
We use NOTES to write music.

In English we use the letters of the **alphabet**.

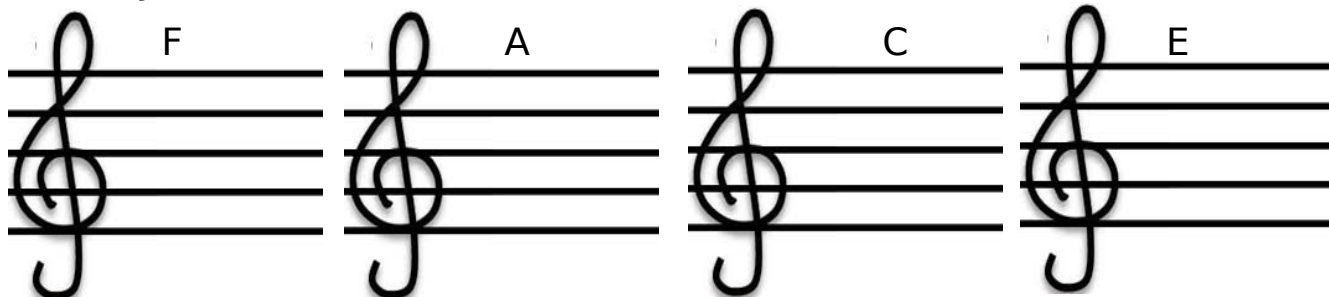


Inside the spaces there are:

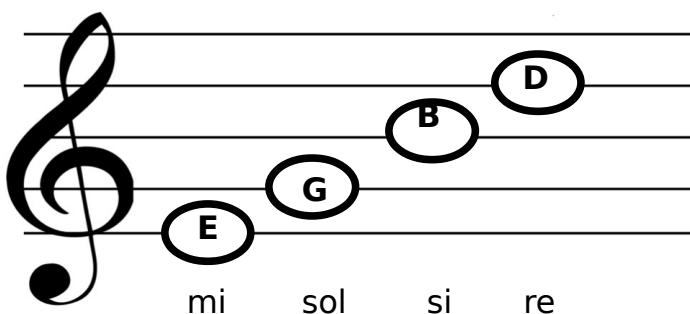


Colour F light green.

Now, you can write the notes.

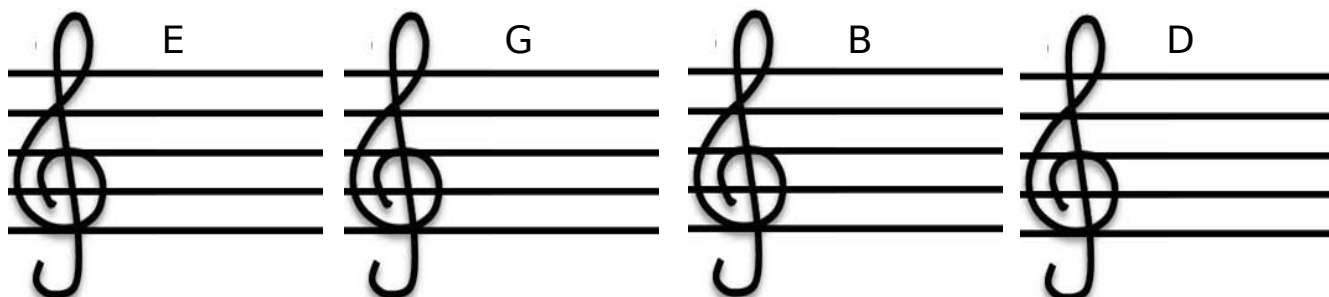


On the lines there are:

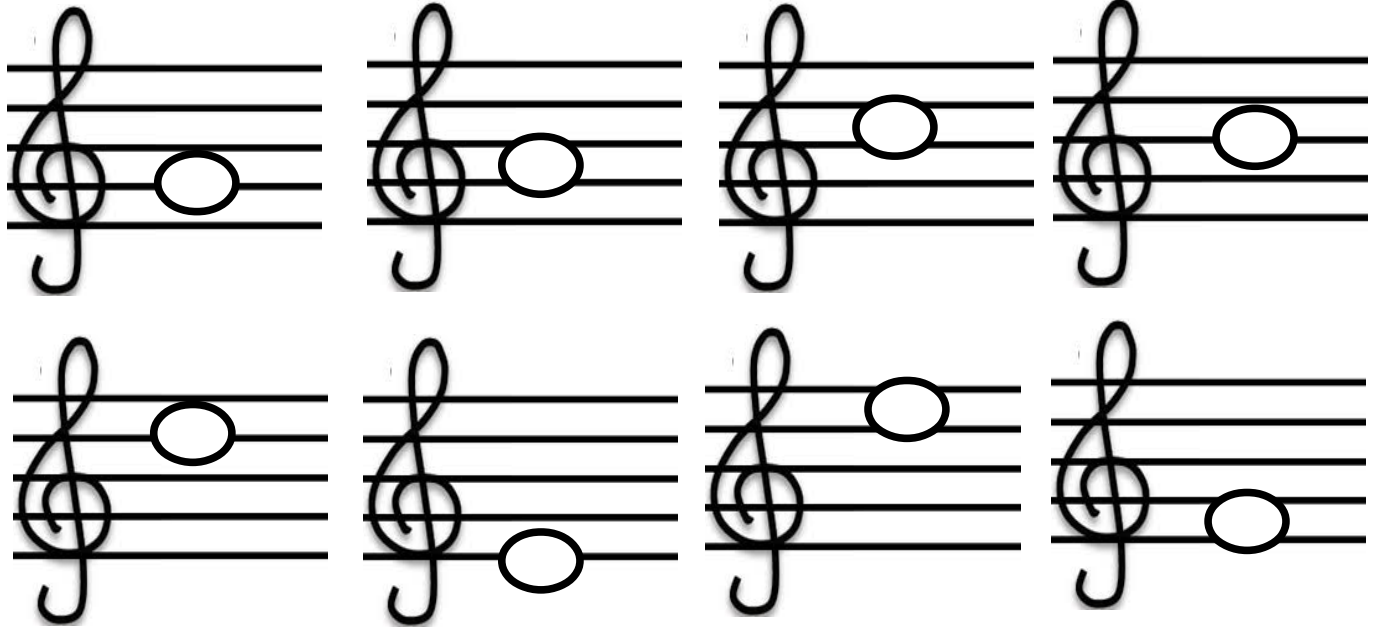


Colour E yellow.

Colour D orange.

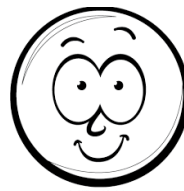
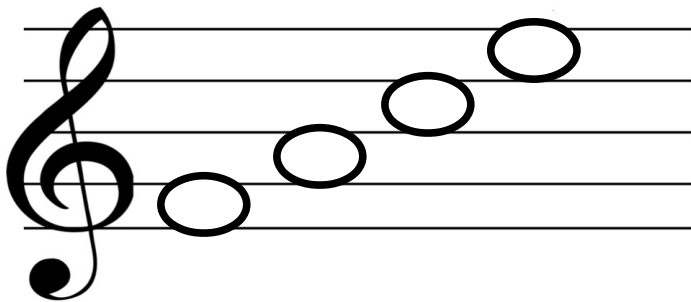
